

Many OFTY professionals fondly recall singing in one of our performances as a young chorister, and treasure that experience as their introduction to musical story-telling. Jeni Houser (left) remembers a long-ago performance in Stoughton as her earliest exposure to opera. Fast forward to January 2020 when Jeni made her Metropolitan Opera debut singing Mozart's Queen of the Night.

OFTY ensures that all students are introduced to opera and the arts through extensive pre-performance teaching materials and an interactive professional performance. Over these past 50 years, we have become a leader in arts eduction and are considered the nation's gold standard in opera outreach. 50 years is just the beginning of our story.

The Wartmanns' Dream

William and Joyce Wartmann's gift of \$100,000 established a fund to be held in perpetuity by OFTY. Their dream was for other generous donors to step forward with the goal of creating a million dollar fund that would provide \$50,000 in revenue each year to OFTY.

OFTY provides a positive introduction to the arts which is crucial to setting young people on a path to personal success, inspiring them toward careers that provide important services for all.


- Students with an education rich in the arts have higher GPAs and standardized test scores and lower drop-out rates - benefits reaped by students regardless of socio-economic status.




About Opera for the Young

Opera for the Young (OFTY) is a preeminent producer and presenter of opera for children in the United States, and since 1970 **we have introduced more than 2.5 million children to opera**. OFTY is unique - children's opera is our sole focus. The 2019/20 production, *The Pirates of Penzance*, will be an introduction to opera for over 75,000 children.

Opera for the Young® brings live, professional opera to elementary audiences with Fall and Spring tours. **Students perform onstage** in chorus and cameo roles, acting and singing for their peers right alongside OFTY's professional artists. All productions are fully staged, sung in English and adapted for kids.

Opera for the Young® keeps school performances affordable through fundraising. We offer our programming to schools at 40% of the actual cost through the generous support of individuals, corporations, foundations and government funding.
